
Read this manual before use. Operation of this nozzle without understanding the manual or receiving proper training can be dangerous and is a misuse of this equipment.

Operating Handle Body Protection Bumper Selectable Gallonage Nozzle. Spinning Teeth. Flushing without shut-off. Fog & Straight Stream flow pattern. Easy and smooth open/close Ball Valve.

1. OPERATION FLOW

- 1) Check all the rotating parts of the nozzle (Handle, Nut, Rubber Bumper) for smooth rotation and connect the nozzle to the fire hose.
- Nozzle should be connected to the fire hose tightly by wrench until the rubber packing in the nut is pressed.
- 3) Hold the Pistol Grip of the nozzle with one hand. The handle should be on "Close" position.
- 4) Adjust flow rate and water pattern to required position and hold tight the nozzle and fire hose in the armpit.
- 5) Turn the nozzle to fire and pull the Handle to "Open" position.
- 6) During fire fighting operation, turn the Rubber Bumper to left or right for fog or straight & stream pattern according to fire condition.
- 7) After fire fighting operation, remove water with dry cloth and store dry and well ventilated place.



2. NOTIFICATION

These nozzles should be used only for fire fighting purpose. Other than fire fighting use may cause unexpected accident.



Do not dis-assemble, repair or modify the nozzle. Dis-assembling, repair or modification without instruction from our customer service may result in damage or injury to the property or operator.



Do not use as a hammer purpose to put away obstacles during fire fighting operation. Any damage on the nozzle by outer force may break-down the parts and cause serious injury to the operator.



Nozzle and fire hose should be connected by wrench until the rubber packing in the nut is pressed. Separation of the nozzle from the fire hose may cause injury to the operator.



Failure to restrain nozzle reaction can cause firefighter injury. The nozzle operator must always be positioned to restrain the nozzle reaction changes caused by change of flow rate, flow pattern or valve open/close.

3. MAINTENANCE

1) After **Operation** : Remove water with dry cloth and keep dry and well ventilated place.

Check the damage of the thread on the connection parts or any other parts of the nozzle.

2) Periodic Check : Rotation of the Nut should be regularly checked at least once a month.
